The destination

Most of the volunteer programs are located in Curitiba, which is the capital and largest city of the Brazilian state of Paraná. The historic quarter of Curitiba features preserved colonial nineteenth century buildings. Much of the center is closed to traffic, making it very pedestrian friendly. Curitiba is rich with warm and welcoming people and vibrant culture. Known as the Ecological Capital of Brazil, Curitiba is one of the most prosperous and organized cities in Brazil. Much of Curitiba itself can be explored on foot. Combine this with a steady climate of warm, balmy temperatures, and it's no wonder that Curitiba's residents like to spend as much of their time as they can outdoors. Volunteers may be placed in Rio de Janeiro or Florianópolis depending on volunteer project.

Projects

Teaching & Childcare

Volunteers can help kids from infants to 12 years old at a children's home, where they strive to meet all their needs - both physical and psychological. Volunteers help care for the children, promote recreational activities, help with homework, and teach basic English. Another placement is with an organization that works to qualify teenagers at social risk to enter the labor market. Volunteers participate in classes to connect with students, teach English classes, prepare cultural classes, presentations and activities, and accompany students on

field trips.

Community Development

Volunteers work with an organization that helps children between 6-12 years old realize their true potential and strive toward their dreams and goals. Volunteers organize recreational activities, teach and help with art projects, assist teachers with workshops, help in the garden, and assist with renovation and infrastructure projects at the center. Volunteers can also share new activities and games at the community center.

Wildlife Conservation

Volunteers help at a wildlife rescue center near Florianópolis where injured animals are rescued, rehabilitated and reintegrated in their natural habitat. This organization cares for all species of Brazilian fauna that have been seized or have been harmed by humans. The center also provides education for the community by conducting workshops about conservation, sustainability, animal welfare and rehabilitation, and safely helping stranded marine animals. Volunteers separate and prepare food for the animals, feed the animals, clean the enclosures, maintain the facility, and treat and care for the animals.
