Summer Program in Film Making

 **Who can apply:**
Everyone can apply, but the program is suggested to:

- Students, new graduates (up to 18 months from graduation) and Master's course students of the Faculties of:
 - Literature and Philosophy
 - Linguistic Sciences
 - Interfaculty LIMED and CIMO
 - Political and social sciences
- Young professionals

The course

The main focus of the Summer program at the School of Visual Arts of New York City is on screenwriting, directing and editing.

What makes the school special is the teaching method which concentrates on filmmaking not just from the technical point of view but also teaches students how to use film as a means of expression of a personal voice, as a way to move people and to inspire emotion.

This intensive course is very practical and covers a wide range of subjects through class lessons, meeting with experts in the sector, and programmed events.

The objective of the course is to teach how to develop a story, from the initial idea right up to post production. Students will experiment the American approach to filmmaking through teamwork and supervision by professionals who work in the film industry.

The courses will be conducted in English.

Program fees

UCSC students and UCSC recent graduates (less than 18 months): € 2,975 + € 35 non-refundable application fee.

External participants or UCSC graduates of more than 18 months from graduation: € 3,220 + € 35 non-refundable application fee.

The above cost includes:

- Course and guest lectures
- Official attendance certificate
- Accommodation
- Breakfast
- Welcome dinner
- Farewell dinner
- Insurance
- Airport pick-up and drop-off (for the largest group)
- Metro ticket for the week of production

Not included:

- Airfare
- Lunches and dinners
- ESTA tax, for entry in the US to enter the USA

Scholarships

15 scholarships of € 500 each will be available, to partially cover program costs.

To apply for a scholarship students simply have to sign up for the program.

The scholarships are reserved for UCSC students and recent graduates (18 months). The scholarship will be paid after the course. Students will have to show a receipt for their air tickets, their boarding passes and a final report recounting the experience.

How to apply

1. [Fill out the application form](#)
2. [Pay the € 35 applicaton fee](#) (non refundable)
3. Apply for the English test
All students must provide certification of their level English. If you have no valid English language certification you must enroll for the UCSC International test.

If you have language certification, in order not to sit the UCSC International language test you must submit a copy of any of the following certificates dated no earlier than two years before application: Cambridge FCE, CAE; IELTS minimum 6; TOEFL minimum 80.

NB: the UCSC International language test takes account of written and oral English and is aimed at testing that candidates have a level of English which will allow them to follow the courses abroad. An intermediate (B2) level is normally required.

4. Have an interview with the Faculty

Payment

Following the enrollment deadline, selected students will be contacted and asked to confirm their intention to participate in the program by submitting the first tuition payment. The group of confirmed students will then be invited to a program orientation meeting. Part of the program will include a mandatory pre departure workshop for all participants.

Reimbursement Policy

In the case of enrollment cancellation, it is possible to request a reimbursement according to the following schedule:

- Cancellation requested after payment and before March 30: 50% reimbursement
- Cancellation requested at least 30 days before the program start date: 10% reimbursement
- Cancellation requested less than 30 days before the program start date: no reimbursement
